**NOMINATION OF THE BRIGHTON
TRAIN DEPOT FOR HISTORIC
LANDMARK DESIGNATION**

The structure is addressed as 269 East Bridge Street, and is more specifically located on portions of Lot A and portions of Lot 1 both lying within Block 1 of the Malcom's Addition to Brighton Subdivision in Brighton, Colorado.

The public hearing is scheduled to be held on October 16, 2018 at 7:00 pm. The City Council meeting will take place in the City Council Chambers, located on the first floor of City Hall at 500 South 4th Avenue in Brighton. The City Council will hear evidence from interested parties and make a determination, at first reading, regarding the nomination.
