THE ELEVATOR AND CONVEYANCE CODE, Article 5.5 of Title 9, Colorado Revised Statutes, and Colorado Department of Labor and Employment, Division of Oil and Gas and Public Safety Regulations, Conveyance Regulations, 7 Code of Colorado Regulations 1101-8.

The City Council will hold a PUBLIC HEARING to consider the adoption of an ordinance to adopt, by reference with local amendments, the above mentioned building safety codes.
