

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-103

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF HALLMARK, INC. AND APPROVING THE PROCUREMENT OF THE COLORADO FRONT RANGE TRAIL (CFRT) VETERAN'S PARK TRAIL CONNECTION PROJECT FOR THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF NINE HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FOURTEEN DOLLARS (\$948,214), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado (the "City") desires to add a ten-foot wide, roughly 400-foot concrete trail and other necessary ROW stormwater improvements to create an east-west trail connection from Veteran's Park to the Highway 85 roundabout; and

WHEREAS, the City published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process for the CFRT Veteran's Park Trail Connection Project, Project #24-008769 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriation exists for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Hallmark, Inc. submitted a bid for the Project in the amount of \$948,214 (the "Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes Hallmark, Inc. is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Proposal of Hallmark, Inc. is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney is hereby authorized to sign the contract for the Project with Hallmark, Inc. on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
