

### Project Details

- 3 Locations of Project work – Colorado Park, Sister Cities Park, & Footprint Park
- Colorado Park includes playground & poured-in-place surfacing
- Sister Cities Park and Footprint Park include only surfacing
- Poured-in-place surfacing is considered a handicap accessible & ADA approved surface
- Request for Proposals (RFP) – 5 firms submitted RFPs
- Staff scored the 5 proposals based on criteria listed in the RFP
- STAR Playgrounds was the most responsive and responsible submittal
- STAR Playgrounds met the RFP requirements and had the highest score of 93.5%
- The proposal from STAR is within the budgeted amount for the Project
- Construction will occur in 2020

## COLORADO PARK PLAYGROUND

### Project Details


- Project is funded through an Adams County Open Space Grant for the playground at \$240,400.00, and the City's Approved 2019 Annual Budget – Recreation Capital – Colorado Park Improvements line item
- This playground is only one part of a total Park Improvements Project that includes trail, parking lot, new basketball court, lighting for tennis & basketball, and more
- Removal of the old playground was previously approved by City Council in the Colorado Park Improvements Project
- Playground Project includes:
  - Installation of new play equipment and structures
  - New poured-in-place surfacing
- Playground to have a theme fitting its name (Colorado) – theme will be shown in the play structures and surfacing




## POURED-IN-PLACE SURFACING AT SISTER CITIES PARK & FOOTPRINT PARK

### ■ Project Details

- The City received a favorable proposal by including, with the Colorado Park Playground, the poured-in-place surfacing at Sister Cities Park & Footprint Park
- Engineered wood fiber and rubber crumble will be removed from Sister Cities Park playground and Castlegate
- Sister Cities Park playground and the Castlegate climbing structure will be combined together with one poured-in-place surface
- Engineered wood fiber will be removed from the west side of the Footprint Park playground, and a new poured-in-place surface will be installed





## RFP AWARD REQUEST

The most responsive and responsible RFP to perform the required services is STAR Playgrounds.

Staff recommends to City Council the awarding of a contract for the project entitled Colorado Park Playground and Surfacing of Sister Cities Park and Footprint Park Playgrounds to STAR Playgrounds in the amount of \$324,444.25.
