

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING THE PLACEMENT OF A PLAQUE ON MEMORIAL PARKWAY RECOGNIZING ELAINE PADILLA FOR HER SERVICE TO THE BRIGHTON COMMUNITY.**

**Resolution No. 2018-70**

**WHEREAS**, heretofore, the City Council of the City of Brighton adopted Resolution No. 03-14, establishing a Policy for the naming of public amenities and park and recreation facilities in the City of Brighton, including the procedure for selecting Names for recognition on the Memorial Parkway (the “Naming Policy”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Clerk has received one Petition, submitted pursuant to and in accordance with the Naming Policy, requesting recognition of Elaine Padilla for her service to the Brighton Community; and

**WHEREAS**, Elaine Padilla Exemplified the true spirit of volunteerism in Brighton. She was involved in the Police Athletic League Wrestling Program, Girl Scouts and served on the first bilingual committee in the 27J School District. Elaine was honored with several awards including: 9Who Care, the Liberty Bell Award from the Adams County Bar Association and was named Brighton’s Outstanding Citizen of the Year in 2004; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board has reviewed the Petition, and has found and determined that the Petition properly meets all of the relevant criteria established by the Naming Policy; and

**WHEREAS**, The Park and Recreation Advisory Board at their meeting of April 4, 2018 recommended that Elaine Padilla be recognized for her service to the Brighton Community by placing a plaque on the Memorial Parkway; and

**WHEREAS**, The City Council finds and determines that The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, at their meeting of April 4, 2018, did unanimously approve the motion recommending to the City Council, the Advisory’s Board’s support for the Petition, and the placement of a plaque on the Memorial Parkway recognizing Elaine Padilla for her service to the Brighton Community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Brighton, that:

1. A plaque be placed on the Memorial Parkway recognizing Elaine Padilla for her service to the Brighton Community.
