

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, SUPPORTING THE GRANT APPLICATION AND MATCHING FUNDS FOR THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FY2022 REBUILDING AMERICAN INFRASTRUCTURE WITH SUSTAINABILITY AND EQUITY (RAISE) PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation is currently soliciting proposals for grant funding assistance under their *FY 2022 for Local and Regional Project Program Assistance Grants* (or “RAISE”) program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton recognizes the importance of building and maintaining a supportable and sustainable infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to reduce traffic congestion, improve multi-modal opportunities and fulfill the goals set forth in both its Transportation Master Plan and Vision ZERO Plan; and

WHEREAS, City staff has identified a shovel-ready project in the form of widening Brighton’s Bridge Street that is expected to direct traffic more efficiently, improve pedestrian safety by constructing sidewalks, and promote multimodal infrastructure by renovating existing bus facilities as well as constructing new facilities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. City Council expresses its support for the grant application and directs the City Manager, or his or her designee to provide final review, to execute, and submit, on behalf of the City of Brighton, an application for the Department of Transportation’s RAISE program in the amount of at least \$12,000,000.

Section 2. The City is capable of providing the amount of funding and in-kind contributions as specified in the application up to \$4,000,000 or 25% of the total project costs.

Section 3. The City will work with the Department of Transportation to meet established deadlines for entering into a grant or cooperative agreement, and to meet all associated grant reporting requirements.

Section 4. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
