

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-90

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO CALLING FOR A RECALL ELECTION TO TAKE PLACE AS PART OF THE COORDINATED ELECTION TO BE CONDUCTED BY THE ADAMS COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER AND THE WELD COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER ON NOVEMBER 5, 2019 AND PROVIDING THAT THE CITY WILL UTILIZE THE REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES OF THE “UNIFORM ELECTION CODE OF 1992” FOR SAID ELECTION

WHEREAS, a recall petition was filed with the Office of the City Clerk on August 5, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk deemed the recall petition sufficient on August 12, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the challenge period has elapsed without any challenges to the recall petition being filed; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. §31-4-503(4) and Brighton City Charter, Article VI, Section 6.3(E) require that the governing body order and fix the recall election recall election with the next regular election when such election is within 180 days or 90 days, respectively, of the submission of the petition to the governing body; and

WHEREAS, November 5, 2019 is a regular election and a designated coordinated election date under state law; and

WHEREAS, the Adams County Clerk and Recorder and the Weld County Clerk and Recorder are the coordinated election officials responsible for conducting the election on behalf of the participating governmental jurisdictions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Brighton City Council orders the recall election to take place as part of the coordinated election on November 5, 2019, which shall be conducted by the Adams County Clerk and Recorder and the Weld County Clerk and Recorder.

Section 2. The City of Brighton will utilize the requirements and procedures the Uniform Election Code of 1992 for the 2019 coordinated election.
