


OVERVIEW

- Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on Homelessness



KEY **COMPONENTS** OF MOU

- Three-year term that can renew annually
- Share data and create a central hub to analyze root causes and best solutions to homelessness
- · Use data to identify
- Work with Core Team to deliver outputs and outcomes



COLLABORATION OUTCOME: TRANSPORTATION ACCESS






