

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING THE NAMING OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD PARK LOCATED WITHIN TRACT N OF BRIGHTON EAST FARMS SUBDIVISION AS HARVEST PARK

WHEREAS, heretofore, the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado (“City Council”), adopted Resolution No. 03-14 establishing a policy for the naming of public amenities and parks and recreation facilities in the City of Brighton, including open space parcels (the “Naming Policy”); and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has received one petition, submitted pursuant to and in accordance with the Naming Policy (“Petition”), requesting the naming of the neighborhood park located within Tract N of Brighton East Farms Subdivision, Brighton, Colorado, as “Harvest Park;” and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board (“Board”) has reviewed the Petition, and has found and determined that the Petition properly meets all of the relevant criteria established by the Naming Policy; and

WHEREAS, at their meeting on December 5, 2018, the Board did unanimously approve the motion supporting the Petition and the naming of the neighborhood park as “Harvest Park.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The neighborhood park located within Tract N of Brighton East Farms Subdivision, Brighton, Colorado, shall be named and hereafter known as “Harvest Park.”

Section 2. A City of Brighton sign bearing such name shall be prepared, dedicated, and placed on the property by the City.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions of the City in direct conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
