A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF ASPHALT SPECIALTIES CO., INC. AND APPROVING THE PROCUREMENT OF THE ASPHALT PORTION OF THE TRANSPORTATION PRESERVATION AND IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$1,890,825), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton (the "City") desires to repair and preserve infrastructure, increase traffic and pedestrian safety, and improve drainage within the City by performing asphalt maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the City published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process for the asphalt portion of the Transportation Preservation and Improvement Project, Project No. 26500161 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriations exist for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Asphalt Specialties Co., Inc. ("ASC") submitted a bid for the Project in the amount of \$1,890,825 ("Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes ASC is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the procurement followed Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code and the requirements and procedures for contracting public works or professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Proposal of ASC is hereby approved.

Section 2. The City Manager, after consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to execute the contract with ASC in an amount of \$1,890,825 for the Project on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
