

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-73

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AWARDING A MASTER PRICE AGREEMENT TO TAT CONSTRUCTION, LLC FOR THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL REWIRE PROJECT FOR THE INITIAL ANNUAL NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$160,000.00) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado (“City”), published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process for Traffic Signal Rewire Project, Project #22-007252M (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriation exists for the Project; and

WHEREAS, TAT Construction, LLC (“TAT”) submitted a bid for the Project (“Proposal”); and

WHEREAS, the City believes it is in the best interest of the City to execute a Master Price Agreement with TAT for the Project with an initial annual not-to-exceed value of \$160,000.00 (the “Master Price Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Master Price Agreement allows the City to execute up to four one-year options to renew based on the terms set forth in the solicitation documents and the Master Price Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that TAT is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, “The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies;” and

WHEREAS, Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Proposal of TAT is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to execute the Master Price Agreement, with TAT Construction, LLC for the Project.

Section 3. Further, the City Manager or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is authorized to executed up to four one-year options to renew the Master Price Agreement based on the terms set forth in the solicitation documents and the Master Price Agreement

Section 4. This resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
