


Purpose

Gym Improvements

- Expanded Youth Basketball game and practice space
- Sports camps and other programming can be held while keeping open gym access
- Additional Pickleball courts
- New and expanded youth programming and nonsports camps
- Gym Storage
- Additional Office Space



The Recreation Department has seen continued growth in youth and adult programming.

Concurrently, the availability of gym space through 27J has decreased. We will be addressing staff office space as well. The project approach is to build a multiuse space that can address numerous needs.
