**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS WATER ACTIVITY ENTERPRISE, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT 18-HA1-XC-00059 BETWEEN THE CITY OF BRIGHTON AND THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF VETERANS' PARK WATER QUALITY PROJECT PWQ 0073-009 (21691) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY.**

### **RESOLUTION NO. 2018-18**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Brighton and the Colorado Department of Transportation have previously entered into intergovernmental agreement 17-HA1-ZH-00135 to design and construct a water quality facility and appurtenances to treat stormwater runoff from portions of the City of Brighton and Colorado Department of Transportation right-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, the vast majority of the area treated by the water quality facility is located within the City of Brighton municipal boundary; and

**WHEREAS**, the water quality facility is located on property owned and currently maintained by the City of Brighton; and

**WHEREAS**, the project and maintenance of the water quality facility will provide a great benefit to the City of Brighton by reducing the amount trash and pollutants that enter local waterways; and

**WHEREAS**, the Intergovernmental Agreement is beneficial to both parties; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that the terms of the Intergovernmental Agreement are reasonable and the on-going maintenance of the water quality facility and associated appurtenances by the City of Brighton is in the best interest of the City.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE WATER ACTIVITY ENTERPRISE, AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1.** The Veterans' Park Water Quality Project Maintenance Intergovernmental Agreement 18-HA1-XC-00059 between the City of Brighton and Colorado Department of Transportation is hereby approved.
- 2.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute said Intergovernmental Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Brighton.
