A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING THE AMENDED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BRIGHTON AND ADAMS COUNTY REGARDING A JOINT AG INNOVATION SPECIALIST POSITION; APPROVING THE CITY'S NOT TO EXCEED ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION OF FORTY-ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$41,000) WITH AN ANNUAL TWO AND A HALF PERCENT (2.5%) INCREASE TOWARD SAID SPECIALIST POSITION; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID AMENDMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AND THE CITY MANAGER TO UNDERTAKE SUCH TASKS AS MAY BE REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS OF SAID AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton Planning Commission and the Adams County Planning Commission adopted the District Plan in 2016 ("District Plan"), which plan calls for an employee to be shared by the City of Brighton, Colorado ("City"), and Adams County, Colorado ("County"), who will carry out the District Plan's implementation of action items; and

WHEREAS, the City and County entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement on May 2, 2017, to define the hiring, supervision, practical considerations of employment, financial commitments and other responsibilities with respect to the shared employee ("IGA"); and

WHEREAS, a position of Ag Innovation Specialist is the project-designated employee for the District Plan (the "Position"), who began work on June 19, 2017; and

WHEREAS, in order for work to continue on the District Plan, the IGA must be amended to address the next project period for the Position; and

WHEREAS, the City will contribute fifty percent (50%) of the costs as defined in the IGA, up to a total expenditure not to exceed Forty-One Thousand Dollars (\$41,000) with up to a two and a half percent (2.5%) increase annually; and the County will contribute fifty percent (50%) of the costs, up to a total expenditure not to exceed Forty-One Thousand Dollars (\$41,000) with up to a two and a half percent (2.5%) increase annually; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the IGA and the continued support of the Ag Innovation Specialist is an important recognition of the cooperative efforts between the City and the County, and will benefit the implementation of the District Plan for the citizens of Brighton; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further finds and determines that the City's share of the costs for the Ag Innovation Specialist are reasonable in light of the duties associated with the position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Amended IGA between the County and the City regarding a joint Ag Innovation Specialist position is hereby approved.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City's share of the costs for the Joint Ag Innovation Specialist position, as more particularly set forth in the Amended IGA, is approved in an amount not to exceed Forty-One Thousand Dollars (\$41,000) with a two and a half percent (2.5%) increase annually, for no more than three years.

<u>Section 3</u>. The Mayor is authorized to execute the Amended IGA on behalf of the City and the City Clerk to attest thereto.

<u>Section 4</u>. The City Manager is hereby authorized to undertake such tasks and execute such documents as may be required to implement the terms of the Amended IGA.
