

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS WASTEWATER ENTERPRISE, ACCEPTING THE BID OF LAYNE INLINER, LLC, AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE 2015 SEWER LINE REHABILITATION CURED IN PLACE PIPE (CIPP) BID #15-030, TO LAYNE INLINER, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED TWENTY ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$2,321,250.00), AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE CHANGES TO THE CONTRACT AMOUNT UP TO TEN PERCENT (10%) OF THE ORIGINAL CONTRACT AMOUNT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, *“The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies”*; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 3.08 of the Brighton Municipal Code, sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing of supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services; and

WHEREAS, the City published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process for completion of the 2015 Sewer Line Rehabilitation Cured In Place Pipe (CIPP); and

WHEREAS, funding was approved in the 2015 budget for the 2015 Sewer Line Rehabilitation Cured In Place Pipe (CIPP); and

WHEREAS, Layne Inliner, LLC, submitted a bid for the project which has been reviewed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that Layne Inliner, LLC is the lowest and most responsive and responsible bidder for the 2015 Sewer Line Rehabilitation Cured In Place Pipe (CIPP); and

WHEREAS, the City believes that it is in the best interests of the City to accept the bid of Layne Inliner, LLC in the amount of Two Million Three Hundred Twenty One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,321,250.00), to award the contract for the 2015 Sewer Line Rehabilitation Cured In Place Pipe (CIPP) to Layne Inliner, LLC, in an amount not to exceed Two Million Three Hundred Twenty One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,321,250.00), and to authorize the Mayor to sign the contract on behalf of the City and the City Clerk to Attest thereto; and

WHEREAS, Council believes it is in the best interest of the City to authorize the City Manager to approve changes in the contract amount up to 10% of the total contract amount in order to facilitate efficient and responsible project management.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS WASTEWATER ENTERPRISE, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Layne Inliner, LLC is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the 2015 Sewer Line Rehabilitation Cured In Place Pipe (CIPP); and
2. That the bid of Layne Inliner, LLC in the amount of Two Million Three Hundred Twenty One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,321,250.00), is hereby approved; and
3. That the Contract for the 2015 Sewer Line Rehabilitation Cured In Place Pipe (CIPP) is hereby awarded to Layne Inliner, LLC in the amount not to exceed Two Million Three Hundred Twenty One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,321,250.00); and
4. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the contract with Layne Inliner, LLC on behalf of the City and the City Clerk to Attest thereto
5. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to approve changes to the contract amount up to ten percent (10%) of the original contract amount.
