

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, REAPPOINTING ADAM KNISS AS A MEMBER OF THE DISTRICT PLAN COMMISSION WITH A TERM TO JANUARY 2024

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council approved Resolution 2017-04 on January 3, 2017, Approving an Intergovernmental Agreement with Adams County Regarding the Formation of a Joint District Plan Commission (the "IGA"); and establishing the District Plan Commission; and

WHEREAS, the IGA provides that the County shall appoint five (5) members to the District Plan Commission and the City shall appoint four (4) members to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council approved Resolution No. 2018-39 on April 3, 2018, amending the *Policy Regarding the Interview and Appointment Procedures for City Boards, Commissions, and Authorities*, to delegate the interview responsibility to certain members of certain designated Boards, Commissions and Authorities; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with Resolution No. 2018-39, the District Plan Commission conducted interviews for the open positions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the District Plan Commission and that it has interested and qualified members in order for it to function and work toward the betterment of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, THAT THE FOLLOWING APPOINTMENT BE MADE.
