**Joint School Resource Officer Program**

Background

School Resource Officers (SRO) are assigned to

- Brighton High School
- Prairie View High School
- Prairie View Middle School
- Overland Trail Middle School
- Vikan Middle School
- Brighton Heritage Academy

## Education as well as enforcement

Educational resources for students and parents in the following areas:

- Alcohol and substance abuse resistance
- Criminal justice system orientation
- Delinquency prevention
- Preventing gang involvement
- Community responsibility

## Funding

- The City and the two schools will divide salary and benefit costs 50/50 with each share being \$51,062.50/year
- The City and the schools will equally divide the cost of school related SRO overtime (cost will vary)
- This position is a 2019 budget request for the Police Department
- SRO training costs will be agreed upon by the City and the schools

## Recommendation

- Staff recommends the City of Brighton enter into a memorandum of understanding with the Bromley East Charter School and Eagle Ridge Academy High School for a joint School Resource Officer program.
- The term of this Agreement shall be eighteen months commencing January 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and terminating June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
