

318 HIGH SCHOOL PARKING ENFORCEMENT

A. POLICY:

It is the intent of this procedure to enforce permit parking on the posted streets around Brighton High School to allow the residents who live in that area unrestricted access to parking in front of their residences during school hours.

B. PROCEDURE:

Parking is allowed by permit only on those streets so posted in the vicinity of the Brighton High School. Each resident may obtain parking passes at the records section of the police department. The passes issued to each resident include:

- 1) Green permanent parking permits issued for each vehicle registered to the resident and;
- 2) Two guest passes to be used at the discretion of the resident for parking in front of their residence. The address shall be written on the pass to indicate which residence the pass belongs to.

NOTE: PARKING PASSES MAY ONLY BE OBTAINED AT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT BY A PERSON WHO RESIDES AT THE RESIDENCE WHERE THE PERMIT IS BEING ISSUED.
