A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE BID OF PERFORMANCE CONSTRUCTION AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR BROMLEY FARM CARRIAGE HOUSE CONSTRUCTION, PROJECT# 19-019, TO PERFORMANCE CONSTRUCTION IN THE AMOUNT OF EIGHTY TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY NINE DOLLARS (\$82,179.00), WITH NO CONTINGENCY FUNDING, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO SIGN THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AND THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST THERETO

WHEREAS, the City believes that Performance Construction is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, "The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies;" and

WHEREAS, Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1.</u> The bid of Performance Construction, in an amount of Eighty Two Thousand One Hundred Seventy Nine Dollars (\$82,179.00), with no Contingency funding is hereby accepted.
- <u>Section 2.</u> The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to sign the contract on behalf of the City, and the City Clerk to attest thereto.
- <u>Section 3.</u> All resolutions or parts of resolutions of the City in direct conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
