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## Project Overview

- There is an existing, substandard weir measurement structure for the ditch north of Baseline Road and east of the South Platte River.
- The structure is used for the measurement of City augmentation water flows and reports data through the City's SCADA system.
- The ditch conveys stormwater runoff as well.
- A more accurate measurement structure, which can account for a wider range of flows, is needed for proper augmentation accounting.
