

BRIGHTON CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO APPROVING CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 TO THE CITY OF BRIGHTON CONTRACT WITH A-1 CHIPSEAL CO. FOR THE 2017 CIP – SLURRY AND CHIP SEAL PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$450,000); APPROVING THE CONTRACT WITH A-1 CHIPSEAL CO. WITH CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$1,166,545); AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 ON BEHALF OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the 2017 CIP – SLURRY AND CHIP SEAL PROGRAM was approved by the City Council and budgeted in 2017; and

WHEREAS, City Council approved a supplemental budget increasing the funding for the Streets Repairs and Maintenance account by \$450,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton Streets and Fleet Department has identified an allocated amount of quantities in the dollar amount not to exceed \$450,000; and

WHEREAS, the current contract for the 2017 CIP – SLURRY AND CHIP SEAL PROGRAM was awarded for \$866,545 to A-1 Chipseal Company; and

WHEREAS, the total contract amount with A-1 Chipseal with Change Order No. 1 will increase to \$1,166,545.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Change Order No. 1 to the Contract by and between the City of Brighton and A-1 Chipseal Company for the additional associated services for the 2017 CIP – Chipseal/Slurry Program is hereby approved in the amount not to exceed \$450,000.
2. That the City Manager is authorized to sign said Change Order No. 1 on behalf of the City.
3. The total contract amount for the 2017 CIP – Chipseal/Slurry Program with A-1 Chipseal Company for the Project is hereby approved in the amount not to exceed \$1,166,545.
4. That the City Manager is authorized to undertake such tasks and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement Change Order No. 1 and complete the Project.
