

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, CALLING FOR A SPECIAL MAIL BALLOT MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR WARD 2, TO BE HELD ON APRIL 28, 2020; APPOINTING THE BRIGHTON CITY CLERK AS THE DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL; SPECIFYING THE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY CLERK REGARDING THE CONDUCT OF THE ELECTION; AND SETTING FORTH OTHER DETAILS RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2019, Ward 2 Councilmember Gregory Mills was sworn in as Mayor to fill a vacancy pursuant to the City of Brighton Charter, Section 4.8 (B) creating a vacancy in Ward 2; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Brighton Charter, Section 4.8 (D)(3), Council may call for a special election within that ward to fill the vacated seat for the remainder of the unexpired term.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That a Special Mail Ballot Election by the voters of the City of Brighton to select the Council Member for Ward 2 shall be held on April 28, 2020.
2. Every person who has attained the age of eighteen years, is a citizen of the United States, resides in the City of Brighton and Ward 2 on April 28, 2020 and has registered to vote on or before April 28, 2020, shall be eligible to vote in this Special Mail Ballot Election for Ward 2.
3. The City Clerk is hereby appointed as the Designated Election Official for the April 28, 2020 Special Mail Ballot Election for Ward 2.
4. The City Clerk shall certify the ballot content, publish a notice of election, appoint election judges, mail the ballots and designate the location for the special election consistent with the requirements of the City of Brighton Charter and other applicable law.
5. The City Clerk is authorized to certify the ballot content and shall notify the County Clerk of Adams County and the County Clerk of Weld County of this Special Mail Ballot Election for Ward 2 and that the list of registered voters shall be supplemented on March 27, 2020, by the County Clerks, including all persons registering to vote on or before March 27, 2020.
