

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF ATOZ RECREATION, LLC FOR THE WATER TOWER PARK PLAYGROUND PROJECT FOR THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED NINETY-THREE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$393,700) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado (the “City”) desires to add an ADA accessible playground for the community and patrons visiting Water Tower Park; and

WHEREAS, the City published a notice inviting bids through its formal solicitation process for the Water Tower Improvement – Playground, Project #23-001d (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriation exists for the Project; and

WHEREAS, AtoZ Recreation, LLC (“AtoZ”), submitted a bid for the Project in the amount of \$393,700.00 (the “Proposal”); and

WHEREAS, the City believes that AtoZ is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter: “The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies”; and

WHEREAS, Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Proposal of AtoZ is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to sign the contract for the Project with AtoZ on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
