



Review Criteria

- Per the Special District Act, Article 1, Title 32 of the Colorado Revised Statues, service plans must include the following items:
 - o Description of services,
 - o Financial information,
 - o Preliminary engineering or architectural survey showing how the services are to be provided,
 - Map of boundaries,
 - Estimated population at build-out,
 - Estimated assessed valuation at build-out,
 - o General description of facilities to be constructed,
 - Estimated costs of land acquisition, engineering, legal and administrative costs, and costs related to the organization and initial operation of the district,
 - o Description and form of any proposed Intergovernmental Agreements (IGAs), and
 - Other information set by State Statutes or required by the approving jurisdiction(s).





Public Notice and Comment

- No public comments have been received by the Planning Division as of the afternoon of September 18th.


