

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-48

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING CHANGE ORDER NO.1 TO THE CONTRACT WITH J.R. ENGINEERING, LLC FOR THE BRIDGE STREET WIDENING DESIGN SERVICES PROJECT, PROJECT #20-006515, IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED ELEVEN DOLLARS (\$407,511.00)

WHEREAS, the City Council awarded the Bridge Street Widening (22nd Avenue to 45th Street) Design Services contract (the “Contract”) to JR Engineering, LLC as the most responsive and responsible bidder, on April 6, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of the Contract was eight hundred twenty-eight thousand eight hundred forty-five dollars (\$828,845.00); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to add additional scope of work to the Contract to design utilities, subsurface utility investigation, and design services to support the RAISE grant application and increase the Contract time by 60 days (“Change Order No. 1”); and

WHEREAS, the amount Change Order No. 1 is four hundred seven thousand five hundred eleven dollars (\$407,511.00), and the total amount of the Contract will be one million two hundred thirty-six thousand three hundred fifty-six dollars (\$1,236,356.00); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriation exists for the Project and the Change Order #1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3-8-90 of the Brighton Municipal Code: “[a]ll materials, supplies, equipment, service and construction contracts . . . with an estimated cost of greater than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), shall be awarded through the formal bid process . . . by the City Council.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Change Order No. 1 is hereby approved and the City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is authorized to execute Change Order No. 1 on behalf of the City.

Section 2. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
