

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO APPROVING THE RENEWAL OF THE 2016-2018 INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN ADAMS COUNTY AND THE CITY OF BRIGHTON FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ENTITLEMENT PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SUCH DOCUMENTS AND UNDERTAKE SUCH TASKS AS MAY BE REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS OF SAID AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton and Adams County entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement (“IGA”) regarding the 2016 – 2018 Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Program (“CDBG Entitlement Program”), in August 2015; and

WHEREAS, the initial term of the IGA covers the CDBG Entitlement Program for a three year period; beginning on March 1, 2016 and ending on February 28, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton and Adams County desire to automatically renew the IGA to address the CDBG Program for 2019-2021 as provided in the IGA; and

WHEREAS, the IGA is funded through the Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) which receives funding annually from Congress, who appropriates funding annually. Such appropriations decide how much funding is available for CDBG; and

WHEREAS, this IGA will remain in effect until the CDBG funds and program income received with respect to activities carried out during the three-year qualification period and any applicable successive qualification periods are expended and the funded activities completed; the County and the City of Brighton cannot terminate or withdraw from the IGA while it remains in effect; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that participation in the CDBG Entitlement Program is a benefit to the citizens of Brighton that the terms of the IGA are reasonable, and it is in the best interests of the City to renew the IGA with Adams County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON THAT:

1. The 2016-2018 Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Brighton and Adams County, Colorado for the Colorado Development Block Grant Entitlement Program, a copy of which is attached hereto, is hereby renewed for an additional three (3) year term.
2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute such documents and undertake such tasks as may be required to implement the terms of Intergovernmental Agreement for the Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Program on behalf of the City.
