

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-40

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING AND ADOPTING A POLICY FOR THE USE OF MOBILE COMPUTING DEVICES PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF BRIGHTON TO ITS ELECTED OFFICIALS, AND, IN PARTICULAR, THE USE DURING SPECIAL AND REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS AND STUDY SESSIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton takes pride in the delivery of effective governmental services in a manner which is environmentally-conscious, efficient, and cost-effective; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton relies extensively on mobile computing devices and technology for its operations, including the regular use of electronic mail, electronic document storage, electronic document transmittal, and electronic data display; and

WHEREAS, the use of mobile computing devices and electronic media conserves natural resources by reducing the amount of paper used in the course of City business; and

WHEREAS, the Brighton City Council has concluded that the provision of a mobile computing device, like an iPad tablet and/or lap top computer, for each elected official for City business is consistent with the City's efforts to remain technologically efficient at all levels; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton reaffirms its commitment to adhere to all applicable requirements of Colorado law regarding open meetings and open records; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton desires to adopt the Mobile Computing Device policy, attached as Exhibit A, as a tool for the efficient, convenient, and proper use of mobile computing devices like iPad tablets and lap top computers, and cellular telephones.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mobile Computing Device Policy, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is approved.

Section 2. Resolution 2013-66 Approving and Adopting a Mobile Computing Device Policy is no longer in effect and replaced with the adoption of this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective upon the date of its adoption.
