

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-73

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A MINI-GRANT APPLICATION TO ADAMS COUNTY FOR THE HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT AT DONELSON PARK; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN AND EXECUTE THE GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado (“City Council”), determined that it is appropriate for the City to apply for funding through the Adams County Open Space Mini-Grant for the High School Seniors Beautification Project at Donelson Park (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the Project contributes to the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Brighton, and that this type of recreational Project is a needed amenity within Brighton; and

WHEREAS, the Project has an estimated total cost of \$5,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City will allocate \$2,500.00 in a cash match in the 2022 Recreation Capital Budget toward the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City finds and determines that it is proper to apply for a \$2,500.00 Mini-Grant from Adams County Open Space to partially fund the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, upon receiving a Grant Agreement from Adams County, will have an opportunity to review the language of the Agreement before authorizing the signing of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

The City Staff is hereby authorized to submit to Adams County the Application for an Adams County Open Space Mini-Grant for the High School Seniors Beautification Project at Donelson Park, and the City Manager is authorized to sign and execute the Application on behalf of the City.
