

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-99

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE BID OF COMMUNICATION CONSTRUCTION & ENGINEERING INC. AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR INSTALL CONDUIT, FIBER AND ELECTRICAL WIRING FOR CEMETERY LIGHT POLES PROJECT #19-025, TO COMMUNICATION CONSTRUCTION & ENGINEERING INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED NINE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHTY ONE DOLLARS AND FORTY TWO CENTS (\$109,781.42), WITH NO CONTINGENCY FUNDING, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO SIGN THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AND THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST THERETO

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado (“City”), published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process for Install Conduit, Fiber and Electrical Wiring for Cemetery Light Poles Project #19-025 (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, funding was approved in the 2019 budget for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Communication Construction & Engineering Inc. submitted a bid for the Project which has been reviewed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that Communication Construction & Engineering Inc. is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, “The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies;” and

WHEREAS, Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The bid of Communication Construction & Engineering Inc., in an amount of One Hundred Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty One Dollars Forty Two Cents (\$109,781.42), with no Contingency funding is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to sign the contract on behalf of the City, and the City Clerk to attest thereto.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions of the City in direct conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
