

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN ACTIVE GRANT APPLICATION TO ADAMS COUNTY FOR THE AICHELMAN PROPERTY – PHASE 1 PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE ACTING CITY MANAGER TO SIGN AND EXECUTE THE APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado (“City Council”), determined that it is appropriate for the City to apply for funding through the Adams County Open Space Grant for the Aichelman Property – Phase 1 Project (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the Project contributes to the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Brighton, and that this type of recreational and open space construction project is a needed amenity within Brighton; and

WHEREAS, the Project has an estimated total cost of \$1,364,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Adams County Open Space Grant Application is for an amount not to exceed \$818,400.00; and

WHEREAS, the City has allocated \$400,000.00 in a cash match toward the Project in the 2020 Recreation Capital Budget and will need to allocate \$49,334.00 in a cash match and \$96,266.00 in in-kind labor and materials in the 2021 Recreation Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS, upon receiving a Grant Agreement from Adams County, the City will have an opportunity to review the Agreement before authorizing the signing of the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. City Staff is hereby authorized to submit to Adams County the Application for an Adams County Open Space Active Grant for the Aichelman Property – Phase 1 Project, and the Acting City Manager is authorized to sign and execute the Application on behalf of the City.
