

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Purpose

- The purpose of this Grant is to assess environmental conditions of public and/or private properties located within the City of Brighton
- The City recently solicited a request for qualifications and proposals for professional environmental services from qualified environmental consulting firms to provide environmental assessment services to the City as outlined in the RFQP and work plan

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Timeline

- The City applied for the grant late in 2022 and was awarded the grant in the spring of 2023
- An RFQP was solicited in September via the City's procurement division
- City staff interviewed the top three firms in October and plan to formalize an agreement with the top firm by the end of 2023 so they can begin work in Q1 2024
- The closeout of the grant should occur by the end of 2027
