

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A LETTER ON BEHALF OF COUNCIL SUPPORTING ADAMS COUNTY'S APPLICATION FOR A VARIANCE TO ESTABLISH THE 5-STAR CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, City Council recognizes that COVID-19 has caused a significant disruption to businesses worldwide and has an immediate detrimental effect on businesses in Brighton; and

WHEREAS, City Council finds and determines the importance of supporting businesses as much as possible; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton has been working with Adams County staff and all of our partners to create a reasonable and sustainable plan to ensure compliance and safety for businesses and customers alike; and

WHEREAS, Adams County intends to submit an application on behalf of the County and all cities within to create a 5-Star Certification Program for certain businesses to safely reopen at defined levels as authorized by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. City Council authorizes the Mayor to sign a letter of support of the variance application to establish the 5-Star Certification program as requested by Adams County.

Section 2. City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute any documents necessary to create and implement the 5-Star Program pending approval.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions of the City in direct conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
