## Why Amend Chapter 8?

- December 2021 Marshall Fire showed the high risk of fire danger in communities along the Front Range
- Extreme weather conditions, including periods of high winds, contribute to fire risk
- To curb the probability of such fires

## Key Definition: *Open fire or open burning*

- Campfires
- Warming fires
- Lighting of fused explosives
- Fireworks
- Lighting of model rockets
- Burning of fence lines or rows
- Burning of grasslands
- Burning of fields
- Burning of farmland/rangeland/wildland
- Burning of trash/debris

## Open fire or open burning definition exclusions:

- (1) fires in liquid-fueled or gas fueled stoves, grill, fireplaces;
- (2) fires in wood-burning fireplaces contained within buildings;
- (3) fires in charcoal grills at private residences;
- (4) commercial, professional, or municipal fireworks displays; and
- (5) prescribed or controlled burns with specific written approval from the Fire Code Official.

## Authority to Declare Restrictions

The City Manager, in consultation with the Fire Marshall of the Brighton Fire Rescue District, may declare stage 1 or stage 2 fire restrictions.

## Stage 1 Restrictions

No fire or campfire.

- Exemptions:
  - (1) a valid permit issued by the Fire Code Official;
  - (2) the performance of an official duty by a political subdivision or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force;
  - (3) stoves, indoor fireplaces, grills at private residences, or ornamental fire pits;
  - (4) fire within a constructed grate at a developed campground.

## Stage 2 Restrictions

Prohibit open burning.

Exceptions:


- Gas fueled stoves, grills, fireplaces
- Fires in wood-burning fireplace inside a building
- Fire in charcoal grill at family residences
- Commercial fireworks displays

## Enforcement

- Violation of ordinance is a misdemeanor.
- Ordinance is enforceable by the Police Department and the Fire Code Official.
