

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-87

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF BURNS & MCDONNELL ENGINEERING COMPANY, INC. TO IMPROVE KEN MITCHELL CELL NO. 3 FOR THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIXTEEN DOLLARS (\$843,916.00) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado (“City”), published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process for the improvement of Ken Mitchell Cell No. 3, Project No. 22-007561 (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriation exists for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company, Inc., (“Burns & McDonnell”) submitted a bid for the Project in the amount of \$843,916.00 (the “Proposal”); and

WHEREAS, the City believes that Burns & McDonnell is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, “The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies;” and

WHEREAS, Section 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Proposal of Burns & McDonnell is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to sign the contract with Burns & McDonnell for the Project on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective upon the date of its adoption.
