

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-77

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF LUCERO CONCRETE CONTRACTORS, LLC FOR THE SPEER CANAL TRAIL PROJECT FOR THE AMOUNT OF SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$628,440.00), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO ISSUE A TASK ORDER FOR SUCH WORK ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado (the “City”) desires to construct a ten-foot concrete trail called the Speer Canal Trail, which will run from East 168th Avenue to Bromley East Charter School at Longspur Drive and will create a north-south connection on the east side of Brighton, Project No. 23-008255 (the “Project”),

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriation exists for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City previously awarded Master Price Agreement 21-006816M.1 (the “MPA”) to Lucero Concrete Contractors, LLC (“Lucero”) for general concrete services, valid through July 28, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Lucero has submitted a quote pursuant to the price schedule set forth in the MPA for the Project in the amount of \$628,440.00 (“Quote”); and

WHEREAS, Section 3-8-180 of the Brighton Municipal Code requires the Quote to be approved by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that it is in the best interest of the City to accept the Quote.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Quote of Lucero is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is authorized to sign the task order with Lucero for the Project on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
