Medical/Retail Sales Licenses Recap

- Required to track all marijuana and products from point of transfer to point of sale
- Products sold must be pre-packaged and clearly labeled
- Sale limits and verification
- Sale shall be immediately recorded in seed-to-sale inventory tracking system
- May contract/transact with medical/retail marijuana products manufacturer licensees
- Retail facilities are prohibited from accepting any retail purchased from a retail cultivation facility unless evidence of applicable taxes paid

CITY ATTORNEY'S	 C-3 – General Retails & Services: Provides wide range retail, service and employment uses at a scale, intensity or in a format that requires a high leve of vehicle accessibility and visibility, typically along corridors or major intersections, and is not easily integrated with other land uses or development patterns. 	1
	 I-1 – Light Industrial: Provides primarily service, employment, manufacturing and distribution uses at a scale, intensity and format that won't have significant impact on adjacent uses, and which can mix with supporting and compatible service and retail uses. 	
	 Not permitted in existing planned developments (PDs) or planned unit developments (PUDs) unless included already as an approved use.
