

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE BID OF BANNER CONCRETE, LLC, AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE COLORADO FRONT RANGE TRAIL (CFRT) – ERGER’S POND SECTION TRAIL PROJECT #17004, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED FORTY TWO THOUSAND NINETY FIVE DOLLARS (\$242,095.00), AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AND THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST THERETO.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, “*The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies*”; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 3.08 of the Brighton Municipal Code, sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing of supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services; and

WHEREAS, the City published a notice inviting Bids through its formal solicitation process for Colorado Front Range Trail (CFRT) – Erger’s Pond Section Trail Project, (ITB #17-029); and

WHEREAS, sufficient funding was approved in the 2017 City of Brighton adopted budget for the Colorado Front Range Trail (CFRT) – Erger’s Pond Section. A State Trails Grant for this project was awarded for \$110,470.00; the City’s match is \$131,625.00. The City’s match is comprised of \$59,052.00 from the Parks and Recreation Capital Improvement fund and \$72,573.00 from the Utilities Water Enterprise fund; and

WHEREAS, Banner Concrete, LLC, submitted a Bid for the project which has been reviewed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that Banner Concrete, LLC, is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Colorado Front Range Trail (CFRT) – Erger’s Pond Section Trail Project; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that it is in the best interests of the City to accept the Bid of Banner Concrete, LLC, in the amount not to exceed of Two Hundred Forty Two Thousand Ninety Five Dollars (\$242,095.00), to award the contract for the Colorado Front Range Trail (CFRT) – Erger’s Pond Section Trail Project to Banner Concrete, LLC, in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Forty Two Thousand Ninety Five Dollars (\$242,095.00), and to authorize the Mayor to sign the contract on behalf of the City and the City Clerk to Attest thereto.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Banner Concrete, LLC, is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Colorado Front Range Trail (CFRT) – Erger’s Pond Section Trail Project; and
2. That the bid of Banner Concrete, LLC, in the amount of Two Hundred Forty Two Thousand Ninety Five Dollars (\$242,095.00), is hereby approved; and

3. That sufficient funding was approved in the 2017 City of Brighton adopted budget for the Colorado Front Range Trail (CFRT) – Erger’s Pond Section Trail Project. A State Trails Grant for this project was awarded for \$110,470.00; the City’s match is \$131,625.00. The City’s match is comprised of \$59,052.00 from the Parks and Recreation Capital Improvement fund and \$72,573.00 from the Utilities Water Enterprise fund; and
4. That the Contract for the Colorado Front Range Trail (CFRT) – Erger’s Pond Section Trail Project is hereby awarded to Banner Concrete, LLC, in the amount not to exceed Two Hundred Forty Two Thousand Ninety Five Dollars (\$242,095.00); and
5. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the contract with Banner Concrete, LLC, on behalf of the City and the City Clerk to Attest thereto.
