A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING THE MASTER PLAN FOR THE "BRIGHTON VIETNAM VETERANS MEMORIAL" AND THE PLACEMENT OF THE MEMORIAL AT 4^{TH} AND JESSUP.

Resolution No. <u>2017-81</u>

WHEREAS, the City Council has received a request to construct a memorial honoring the men and women in the Brighton area who served in the Vietnam War; and

WHEREAS, the Brighton City Council recognizes the sacrifice the men and women serving in all branches of the armed forces who fought in the Vietnam War made and for which they did not receive recognition for their service and sacrifice; and

WHEREAS, the Brighton City Council and the citizens of Brighton wish to recognize and honor the men and women in the Brighton area who sacrificed while serving in the Vietnam War; and

WHEREAS, staff and a representative group of the Vietnam Veterans has developed the Master Plan for the "Brighton Vietnam Veterans Memorial"; and

WHEREAS, staff and the Vietnam Veterans representatives recommend the Memorial be placed on the corner of 4th and Jessup; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that placement of the "Brighton Vietnam Veterans Memorial" on the corner of 4th and Jessup is a fitting location for recognizing the service of the men and women who served in the Vietnam War; and

WHEREAS, the funding for the project will be budgeted in the 2018 Capital Improvement Fund for consideration by the City Council to construct the Memorial.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brighton, that:

- 1. The Master Plan for the "Brighton Vietnam Veterans Memorial" is approved.
- 2. The placement of the "Brighton Vietnam Veterans Memorial" at the corner of 4th and Jessup is approved.
