AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO REPEALING ARTICLE 5-28 <u>CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM</u> OF THE BRIGHTON MUNICIPAL CODE; AND SETTING FORTH OTHER DETAILS RELATED THERETO.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2270, the City of Brighton approved a Franchise Agreement with Comcast Communications Systems for the provision of cable services, for a term of ten (10) years, to expire in 2027; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Article 5-28, Brighton Municipal Code related to the cable television system are out-of-date and have been supplanted by the Comcast Communications System Franchise and Customer Service Standards adopted by Ordinance No. 2270;

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that Article 5-28 is no longer necessary and should be repealed in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Article 5-28, *Cable Television System* of the Brighton Municipal Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the people.

Section 3. Repeal. Article 5-28 is hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance

Section 4. Interpretation. This Ordinance shall be so interpreted and construed as to effectuate its general purpose.
