A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS WATER ACTIVITY ENTERPRISE, TO FIND AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT GOOD CAUSE EXISTS AND THAT IT IS IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE CITY TO WAIVE THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCEDURES FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR ELECTRICAL AND CONTROLS ENGINEERING THE CURRENT SERVICES APPROVE AN EXTENSION OF AND PROFESSIONAL **SERVICES CONTRACT** FOR ELECTRICAL AND **SERVICES** CONTROLS **ENGINEERING** WITH **BROWNS** HILL ENGINEERING & CONTROLS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00) PER HOUR FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2018; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE WATER ACTIVITY ENTERPRISE; AND SETTING FORTH OTHER DETAILS RELATED THERETO.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 31-15-101 (1) c of the Colorado revised Statutes, municipalities are vested with the power to enter into contracts; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-8-10 and 3-08-20 of the Brighton Municipal Code recognize "professional services contracts" as not susceptible to formal sealed-bid procedures, and authorize the City to enter into said contracts, when it is deemed in the best interest of the City to do so; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-8-120 of the Brighton Municipal Code provides that, 'for good cause shown', the City Council can waive the formal procurement process for contracts greater than \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, Browns Hill Engineering & Controls provides expert advice and expertise in electrical and controls engineering services related to design, implementation, and maintenance of electrical and controls systems; and

WHEREAS, Browns Hill Engineering & Controls has extensive knowledge with the electrical and controls systems that currently control basic functionality of some of the City's most complex and critical infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Browns Hill Engineering & Controls has agreed to provide services related to electrical and controls engineering services for the City and enter into a Professional Services Agreement with the City's Water Activity Enterprise; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that Browns Hill Engineering & Controls possesses the expertise and essential knowledge necessary to perform the services as specifically set forth in the subject Agreements and that the terms thereof are reasonable; and

WHEREAS, the rates provided by Browns Hill Engineering & Controls are competitive; and

WHEREAS, this contract will be funded through and limited by available operating budget as approved by the City Council in the calendar year in which work will be completed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that it is in the best interest of the City to waive the formal request for proposal procedures and approve the Professional Services Agreement for Electrical and Controls Engineering Services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS WATER ACTIVITY ENTERPRISE, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. A waiver of formal proposal process for the Professional Services Agreement for Electrical and Controls Engineering Services is hereby approved.
- 2. The Professional Services Agreement for Electrical and Controls Engineering Services with Browns Hill Engineering & Controls in an amount not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) per hour, is hereby approved for calendar year 2018.
- 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the Water Activity Enterprise.
