

The preferred concept was presented to both the Park Board and City Council for recommendation and approval. The Park Board's response was mixed, with opponents expressing similar concerns regarding cost, maintenance, and the homeless. The Park Board cast a five-two vote to recommend the preferred concept. City Council responded positively to the preferred concept but expressed concern for cost and maintenance, suggesting a phasing strategy be included in the plan. A three-phase cost estimate and phasing diagram are provided in Chapter 4.
