


# FRICO-Brighton Bypass Agreement

### Introduction


- ♦ Agreement with FRICO 3 Way
- Brighton gets capacity in an existing water bypass structure on the South Platte River
- Allowing City to move its water rights past the Burlington-O'Brian headgate when it is the senior calling water right.
- This water would otherwise be diverted at that headgate and would be unavailable to Brighton.

### Agreement Items

#### ♦ Brighton Receives:

♦ 5 cfs of permanent capacity in the bypass structure

#### ♦ FRICO Receives:

\$\$125,000 (\$25,000 per cfs), plus \$25,000 for operation and maintenance costs (pro-rata based on flow, estimated to cover 30 years).

cfs - cubic feet of water per second
