



FRICO-Brighton Bypass Agreement

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Introduction

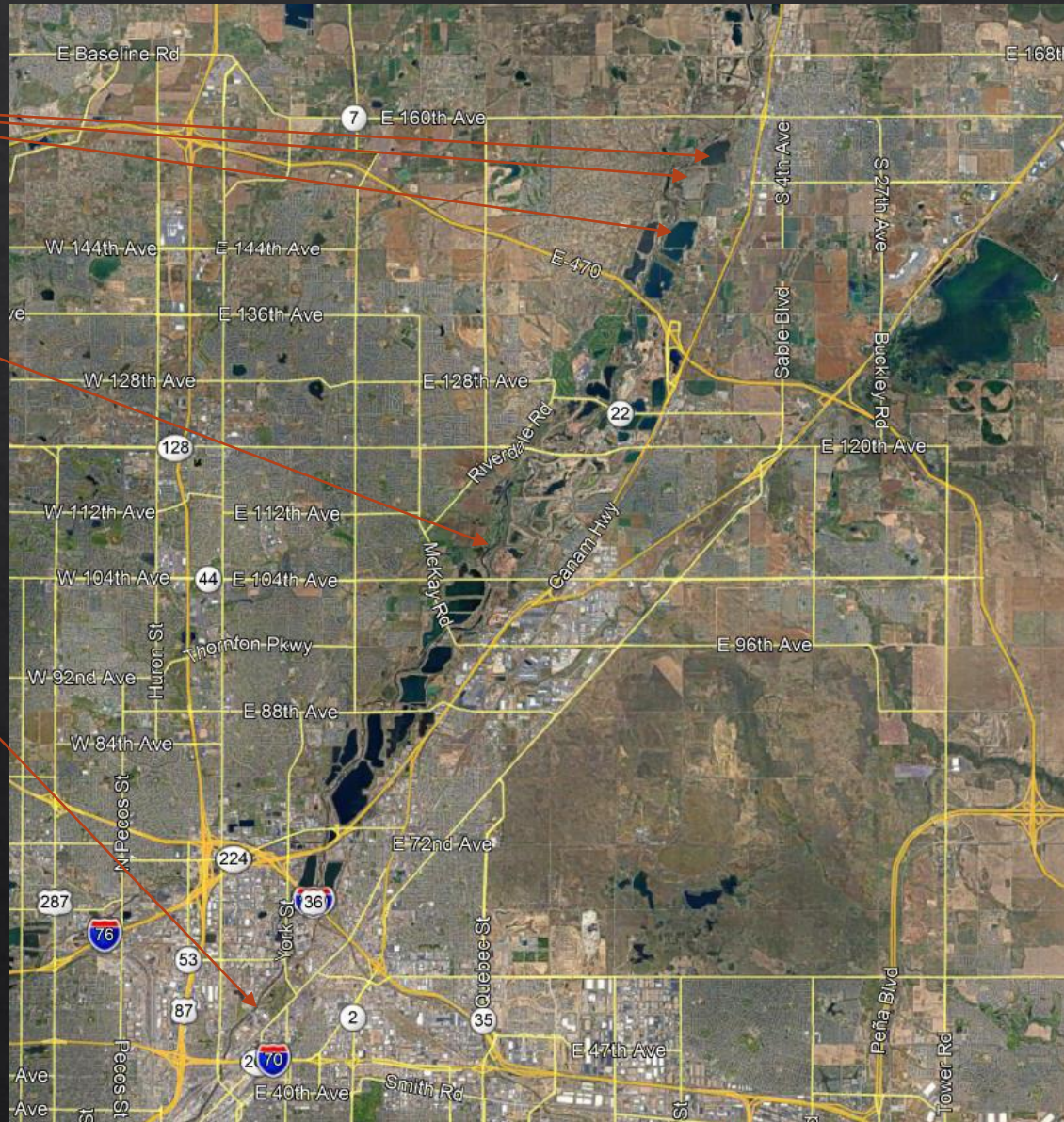
- ◆ Agreement with FRICO – 3 Way
- ◆ Brighton gets capacity in an existing water bypass structure on the South Platte River
- ◆ Allowing City to move its water rights past the Burlington-O'Brian headgate when it is the senior calling water right.
- ◆ This water would otherwise be diverted at that headgate and would be unavailable to Brighton.

Agreement Items

- ◆ Brighton Receives:

- ◆ 5 cfs of permanent capacity in the bypass structure

- ◆ FRICO Receives:

- ◆ \$125,000 (\$25,000 per cfs), plus \$25,000 for operation and maintenance costs (pro-rata based on flow, estimated to cover 30 years).

cfs – cubic feet of water per second
