A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPOINTING JACK D. BAJOREK AS THE CITY ATTORNEY, SETTING FORTH THE TERMS OF HIS APPOINTMENT, AND ESTABLISHING OTHER DETAILS RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, former City Attorney Margaret R. Brubaker retired from City employment July 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2018, the City Council hired Peckham & McKenney, Inc., to lead the recruitment process for a new City Attorney; and

WHEREAS, the recruitment effort resulted in eighteen attorneys applying for the position, and on July 10, 2018, the City Council conducted interviews of four finalists for the position; and

WHEREAS, based on the interviews and a review of the experience of Jack D. Bajorek, the City Council finds and determines that Mr. Bajorek possesses the qualifications and background necessary to successfully undertake the responsibilities and duties of City Attorney; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further determines that it is in the best interests of the City to appoint Mr. Bajorek as the City Attorney according to the terms and conditions set forth in the employment agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and that Mr. Bajorek has agreed to such appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado, as follows:

- **1.** Jack D. Bajorek has the necessary experience and qualifications to serve as City Attorney and meets the requirements of Section 8.1 of the Brighton Home Rule Charter; and
- 2. Jack D. Bajorek is hereby appointed by City Council as the City Attorney effective August 6, 2018, to serve in such position per the Employment Agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and
- **3.** The Mayor is authorized to sign said Employment Agreement on behalf of the City.
