NOMINATION OF THE ADAMS COUNTY CO-OP GROCERY STORE FOR HISTORIC LAND- MARK DESIGNATION

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Brighton will hold a public hearing to consider the nomination of the Adams County Co-op Store, also known as Robb's Grocery Store, for designation as a historic landmark. The structure is addressed as 301 S. Main Street, and is more specifically located on lots 1, 2, 3, & 4 of block 2 of the Brighton Subdivision in Brighton, Colorado.

The public hearing is scheduled to be held on September 4, 2018 at 7:00 pm. The City Council meeting will take place in the City Council Chambers, located on the first floor of City Hall at 500 South 4th Avenue in Brighton. The City Council will hear evidence from interested parties and make a determination, at first reading, regarding the nomination.
