**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Section 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, "*The Council shall* establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies"; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 3.08 of the Brighton Municipal Code, Sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing of supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services; and

**WHEREAS,** the formal solicitation requirement has been met with the award of the City and County of Broomfield Invitation for Bid # 17-016 going to Concrete Conservation Inc.; and

**WHEREAS,** funding for the repair and replacement of manholes in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) was approved by City Council in the 2018 First Quarter Supplemental budget; and

**WHEREAS,** the City believes that it is in the best interests of the City to award the contract for the rehabilitation of approximately ninety one (91) of the City's sewer manholes to Concrete Conservation Inc. in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) and to authorize the Mayor to sign the contract on behalf of the City; and the City Clerk to attest thereto.
