

Project Background

- The South Platte Interceptor Interconnect (SPI) project connects the City's Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP) to Metro's Northern Treatment Plan (NTP)
- ♦ The project was originally bid in July 2016 and was approved by Council on August 2, 2016
- ♦ T. Lowell completed construction in April 2018
- ♦ Since completion, the City has been working with Metro on transferring the ownership and maintenance responsibilities from the City to Metro

Project Details

- ♦ The City and Metro came to agreement on the easement language and are ready to proceed with the signing of the agreement
- Once the easement is transferred, the City can begin sending flows to Metro's NTP



Final Recommendation

- City staff believes approving the easement is in the best interest of the City going forward
- Approving will allow the City to provide waste water flows to Metro's
 NTP per the existing agreement between the City and Metro
- Approving the easement will also alleviate the City from having to maintain any of the infrastructure within the easement boundaries
