

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-143

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BRIGHTON AND THE ADAMS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR THE PROVISION OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AND ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNEL, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AND TO UNDERTAKE SUCH TASKS AND EXECUTE SUCH DOCUMENTS AS MAY BE REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT SAID AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado ("City"), has requested administrative services be provided by the Adams County Sheriff's Office ("Adams County") on a continuous basis between the hours of 10 P.M. and 6 A.M., every day of the year; and

WHEREAS, Brighton and Adams County now wish to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) so that Brighton may use the services of Adams County employees to render, as applicable, administrative services during the aforementioned hours; and

WHEREAS, City Council finds and determines that the terms of the IGA are reasonable, that this IGA exemplifies the spirit of cooperation between the City and Adams County, and that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Brighton that the IGA be approved; and

WHEREAS, Section 18(2)(a) of Article XIV of the Colorado Constitution and Sections 29-1-201, *et seq.*, and 29-20-105 of the Colorado Revised Statutes authorize and encourage local governmental entities to cooperate by contracting with one another for their mutual benefit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The IGA between the City and the Adams County Sheriff's Office is hereby approved.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute said IGA on behalf of the City and to undertake such tasks and execute such documents as may be required to implement said IGA on behalf of the City.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions of the City in direct conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
