A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS WATER ACTIVITY ENTERPRISE, ACCEPTING THE BID OF IMEG CORPORATION AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE GREENSAND FILTER EFFLUENT LINE REPAIR PROJECT TO IMEG CORPORATION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED SEVENTEEN DOLLARS (\$582,617.00) AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AND THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST THERETO

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17.7 of the Brighton City Charter, "The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies"; and

WHEREAS, Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado ("City"), published a notice inviting bids through its formal solicitation process for completion of the Greensand Filter Effluent Line Repair Project (ITB# 18-050) ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, funding was approved in the 2019 budget; and

WHEREAS, IMEG Corporation submitted a bid for the Project in the amount of Five Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand, Six Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$582,617.00), which has been reviewed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that IMEG Corporation is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project, and that it is in the best interests of the City to accept their bid.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The Contract for the Greensand Filter Effluent Line Repair Project is hereby awarded to IMEG Corporation in the amount of Five Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand, Six Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$582,617.00).
- <u>Section 2</u>. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the contract with IMEG Corporation on behalf of the City, and the City Clerk to attest thereto.
