A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO,
APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT REGARDING ANNEXATION
BOUNDARY AND PLANNING COOPERATION WITH THE CITY OF FORT LUPTON

WHEREAS, Brighton and Fort Lupton are parties to an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) dated March 10, 2009 that was intended to address growth and development demands for municipal services within the vicinity of the municipalities especially as related to annexation and planning between the two cities; and

WHEREAS, circumstances have changed since the execution of the 2009 IGA and it is in the best interests of both Parties to terminate and replace the 2009 IGA but to continue to provide for the orderly annexation of properties along the Parties' boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado, has reviewed the IGA and has determined that the terms of said IGA are reasonable and that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Brighton to approve the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado, that the Brighton and Fort Lupton Intergovernmental Agreement, attached hereto as EXHIBIT A, is hereby approved.
